

If you get **SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)** benefits on your Washington Quest Electronic Benefits Transfer (EBT) Card, you can shop at authorized farmer markets. Look for the Quest logo next to the farmers market name. To shop at farmers markets:

- » GO to the farmers market Information Booth.
- » SWIPE your SNAP card and receive tokens.
- » **SPEND** tokens on SNAP-eligible foods.
- » **SNAP** tokens do not expire.



SNAP Market Match gives shoppers who use SNAP EBT extra benefits to spend on fruits and vegetables at participating farmers markets. Look for the SNAP Market Match logo next to the farmers market name.

- » SWIPE your SNAP EBT card at the Info Booth.
- » **RECEIVE** \$1 for every \$1 in SNAP EBT, usually up to \$25 per day.
- » **SHOP** for fresh fruit, vegetables, and herbs. Seniors can also buy honey.
- » SNAP Market Match expires on Dec. 31, 2023.



Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP)

provides participants in Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) and low-income Seniors benefits to spend at farmers markets. Contact your local agencies to sign up.

- » **RECEIVE** WIC or Senior FMNP benefits on an electronic card (new in 2023).
- » **SHOP** for fresh fruits, vegetables, and herbs. Seniors can also buy honey.
- » FMNP can be used June 1 to Oct. 31.
- » New in 2023, WIC participants can use their Fruit and Vegetable Benefits at farmers markets that accept FMNP.

Other Matching Programs

Some farmers markets offer additional benefit or match programs. Check at each market's information booth to see what other benefits programs the market offers.
