We work to ensure that all people have access to nutritious foods and opportunity for physical activity, conducive to lifelong health.





Today's Food Access Forum Vocabulary

ALTSA = Aging and Long-Term Support Admin, part of DSHS

Benefits = FMNP money

CVB = Cash Value Benefits which is same as Fruit & Vegetable Benefits

DOH = Washington State Dept of Health

DSHS = Washington State Dept of Social & Health Services

Farm Stores = Farm stands or produce stands authorized by DOH to accept FMNP

Growers = Farm vendors authorized by DOH to accept FMNP

Issuance = Getting benefits to Seniors or WIC participants

Overallocation = When more money than is actually available is distributed

Participants = Low-income Seniors or families participating in the WIC program


Settlements = Money paid to Growers

SFMNP = Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program

SNAP-Ed = Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) Nutrition Education

WIC = Women, Infants, and Children (WIC) Nutrition Program
