




Electronic Benefits Transfer

- Often used as an interchangeable term with SNAP
- Technically EBT is the card while SNAP is the benefit

Food Access Program Acronyms



Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program

- May also be called Food
 Stamps or EBT
- Eligible for SNAP Market
 Match





SNAP Market Match

 DOH-funded program that increases SNAP customers' spending ability by matching dollar-for-dollar






AKA Summer EBT

- Permanent, nationwide program
- Funds for school age children of EBT-eligible families
- Eligible for SNAP MarketMatch



Farmers Market Nutrition Program (FMNP)



SFMNP

Senior Farmers Market Nutrition Program


- DOH program
- Eligible seniors get \$80 per season to use June-October



WIC

Women, Infants, & Children

- DOH program with many benefits, including FMNP and CVB benefits
- Customers generally refer to their benefits as WIC
- \$30-90/household to use
 June-October



CVB

Cash Value Benefit FRUIT & VEGETABLE

• Year-**BENEFICTS**nefit, allotted monthly

Eligible Items

EBT (SNAP), SUN Bucks

- Fruits, vegetables, mushrooms, fresh herbs
- Vegetable starts and seeds
- Baked goods, bread
- Meat, eggs, dairy products
- Jam, jelly, honey, pickles, nuts, salad dressing

SNAP Market Match

 Produce items only – fruits, vegetables, mushrooms, fresh herbs, vegetable starts

WIC FMNP/Fruit & Vegetable Benefits

• Fresh fruits, vegetables, mushrooms, herbs

Senior FMNP

- Fresh fruits, vegetables, mushrooms, herbs
- Honey

EBT Tokens

CAN be used for these EBT eligible items: (Must be packaged for consumption off site)

- Fruits
- Vegetables
- Vegetable Starts Seeds
- Syrup & Honey Meat/Fish/Poultry

Baked Goods

Jams & Jellies

- Bread
- Dairy Products
- Nuts Mushrooms

NO hot or prepared food or drink products - No cash back given





Debit/Credit Tokens

CAN be used for any market items. They spend just like Cash!



SNAP Market Match

CAN ONLY be used for these eligible items:

- Fruits
- Vegetables Mushrooms
- Herbs
- Vegetable Starts

NO honey, hot/prepared food or drink products - No cash back given

Fresh Fruits & Vegetables Edible Fresh Cut herbs Honey (Seniors ONLY) *No cash back given*









- **SNAP-Ed** Nutrition education branch of the SNAP program





