

## **SNAP-Ed Support with Farmers Markets?**

## There are three ways that local SNAP-Ed staff can work with farmers markets to support nutrition education activities.

#### Either LOCATION or AUDIENCE qualifies

#### **1. ELIGIBLE LOCATION**

The farmers market is located in a **census tract** where 50% or more people who live there are *eligible* for SNAP (200% of federal poverty level).

#### **2. ELIGIBLE AUDIENCE**

50% or more of the activity's participants are *eligible* for SNAP.

#### ALTERNATIVE Criteria

#### **3. ELIGIBLE ALTERNATIVE\***

Alternative criteria can be used to approve SNAP-Ed support at FMs if activities are shown to be "necessary and reasonable" to meet the mission and goals of SNAP-Ed.

### **Books for Kids**

There are two criteria farmers markets must meet to get books from WSFMA (paid for by SNAP-Ed) to give to kids.

- 1. Must be given to children who are eligible for SNAP.
- 2. Must be connected to nutrition education.

The order form will ask you how you/your market will meet these two criteria.


