



## Standing Together Through the Federal Shutdown and SNAP Benefit Impacts

Yesterday, the PDA Council passed a new resolution authorizing an emergency allocation of \$110,000 to the Pike Place Market Foundation to directly strengthen our local food security programs and ensure our community members have access to nutritious meals. These funds will be distributed as follows:

- \$25,000 to the Pike Market Food Bank for the purchase of proteins
- \$30,000 to the Pike Market Senior Center to support its community breakfast and lunch program
- \$15,000 to the Pike Market Child Care and Preschool to support its food program for children
- \$40,000 to expand the Pike Place Market Pike Bucks Program (Highstall)



1 in 9 of downtown Seattle neighbors lost access to food assistance when SNAP benefits expired in Washington State on November 1.

Food programs at the Pike Market Senior Center & Food Bank and The Market Commons are taking immediate action to help our Seattle neighbors access nutritious food.

## **Supreme Court SNAP decision could hit Northwest farmers markets hard**

Yakima County has the highest percentage of residents receiving food stamps in Washington, with more than 57,000 people in the county relying on SNAP, according to a report from the U.S. Sen. Maria Cantwell (D-WA).

“Not only are the people in our community not able to redeem those [benefits]; it's then going to affect our farmers,” Heidi Washam, Downtown Yakima Farmers Market manager, said.

The market had over \$20,000 in SNAP sales this year, said Washam.

She said that money keeps small farms running, and encourages people to get local, fresh produce.





at the Bellingham Farmers Market:

- If you have a balance on your EBT card, you can still get tokens and SNAP Market Match at the info booth to spend at the market.
- SNAP customers with zero remaining balance will not be able to receive Market Match benefits until federal SNAP funding resumes.
