The Market remains committed to providing a safe, welcoming, family-friendly environment for all members of this community.

For that reason, we ask all our customers, vendors, and staff to abide by the following code of conduct:

- No profanity or obscenity. This includes both verbally and written.
- No intimidating or threatening behavior will be tolerated.
- Respect the space and boundaries of those around you.
- No persons under the influence of alcohol or drugs (legal or illicit).
- No smoking within 25 feet of the Market property.
- No shirt, no shoes, no service.
- No leafletting.
- Do not ride scooters, bikes, skateboards, or other such devices inside the Market.
- No audible music or loud singing except in designated busking locations with approval of Market staff.
- Pets are expected to follow Market's Pet Policies at all times.
- We will not tolerate discrimination of any kind – including discrimination based on race, color, national origin, age, perceived or actual physical or mental disability, pregnancy, genetic information, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, marital status, creed, religion, honorably discharged veteran or military status, or use of a trained service animal.
